PROGRAM ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS

Island Exploration @ Cape Fear Education Bld:

Discovery Walk – For curious explorers, students hit the beach with buckets in tow to search for different types of plants and animals that live on or near our shoreline. *2.L.1, 2.G.1, 2.G.2*

Plankton Ecology – Students use microscopes to view some of the small members of the marine community: the plankton. *2.L.1, 2.L.2*

History/Weather @ Cape Fear Education Bld:

Fort Caswell History Hayride – Explore Fort Caswell through a hayride highlighting different structures built throughout the last century and a half. *2.H.1*

Weather Window – Students create a cloud identification and classification tool to use outside for predicting what type of weather may be on the horizon. *2.E.1*
